## What types of services does Aspen provide?

Aspen is a full service home health agency. We provide a broad range of home health services.

### Nursing

We provide comprehensive nursing care services including wound care, tube feeding, and private duty nursing. Registered Nurses (RN) and Licensed Vocational Nurses (LVN) work directly with your physician to provide care tailored to your individual needs. An RN is available for admissions, urgent situations, or questions 24 hours a day.

### Physical Therapy

Physical Therapists (PT) comprehensively assess and implement individual therapy plans for our clients. The focus is on restoration and preservation of our patients' strength and mobility. In addition to administering therapy directly, PTs set up self-directed home exercise programs to assure the best possible outcome.

### Speech Therapy

Speech Therapists (ST) assist clients to recover functionality in swallowing, speaking, listening, reading, and writing.

### Occupational Therapy

Occupational Therapists (OT) comprehensively assess and assist clients to regain functionality in day-to-day activities in both living and working environments. OTs have expertise in working with clients who suffer from physical, developmental, and mental disabilities.

## Respiratory Therapy

Respiratory Therapy (RT) address needs of clients with pulmonary disease and disability including asthma and COPD as well as those undergoing mechanical ventilation at home. RTs address issues related to complex systems of oxygen and inhaled medications administration, invasive and noninvasive ventilator support, and pulmonary self-care.

## Medical Social Services

Our Medical Social Workers (MSW) are professionals with Masters degrees in social work. They counsel patients and family members and assist them to understand and cope with problems caused by illness or disability. In addition, they will plan for continuous programs of care following discharge.

## Home Health Aides

Our Home Health Aides work closely with patients and provide assistance with daily living tasks such as bathing, dressing, meal preparation, and implementing care plans developed by OTs. They are compassionate individuals who are truly interested in helping improve the patient's quality of life.
